Jack D. Rhodes, age 86 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Thursday, January 1, 2015, at Lexington Memorial Hospital.

Born Saturday, December 22, 1928 in Lexington, Missouri to Homer Rhodes and Minnie Lizzie (Strader) Rhodes. He and LaVerne M. Harms were united in marriage on August 23, 1958.

A graduate of Higginsville High School, Jack was a farmer and lived in rural Corder, Missouri until moving to Higginsville in 1998 when he retired.
